APPENDIX 7: OVERALLS, HELMETS & OTHER SAFETY EQUIPMENT

FIA APPENDIX L

All competitors and crews are reminded of the obligation to know and to comply with the Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular regarding Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment (helmets, flame-resistant clothing, frontal head restraint (FHR) and safety belts). These regulations apply to shakedown as well.

Competitors are reminded that all drivers and co-drivers entered in the event must wear:

Helmets

Crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858-2002 or 8858-2010 (Technical List n°41),
- 8859 (Technical List n°49),
- 8860-2004 or 8860-2010 (Technical List n°33), or
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List n°69)

Priority 1 drivers must wear a helmet in accordance with FIA Standard 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP. It is strongly recommended that all drivers in the World Rally Championship wear helmets homologated to the FIA Standard 8860 (Technical List n°33 or Technical List n°69).

Flame resistant clothing

All crews must wear overalls, gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (FIA Technical List n°27) or FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical list n°79).

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR)

The use of FIA approved FHR system is mandatory for all crews.

The wearing of any device intended to protect the head or neck and attached to the helmet is prohibited, unless the device has been homologated according to the FIA Technical List n°29.

Drivers' equipment will be checked at scrutineering, and during the event. Please refer to FIA ISC Appendix L Chapter III for complete information.
